In addition to the APA meetings, a number of social events will be offered. The 12th biennial golf tournament will be held on Sunday, October 24th at Rio Secco Golf Club, www.riosecco.net. The first day of pre-convention meetings will be Monday, October 25th, starting with the Attorneys' Meeting in the morning followed by committee meetings in the afternoon.
